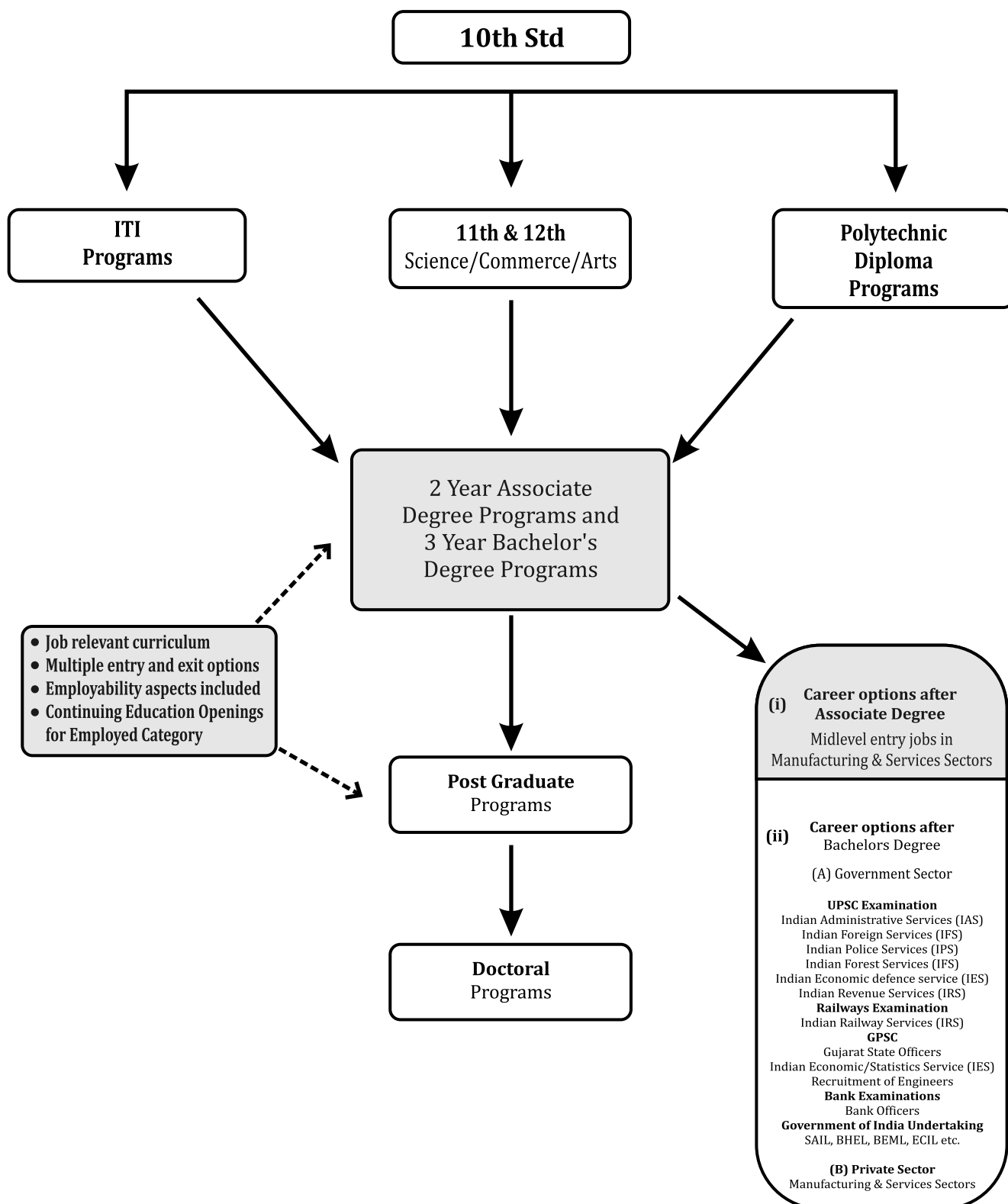

## **TeamLease Skills University (TLSU) is India's First Vocational Skills University.**

TLSU has been established as a Private University with effect from 22nd April 2013; under Public-Private-Partnership mode with the Government of Gujarat, through the Gazette Notification (Gujarat Act No. 18 of 2013) under Gujarat Private University (Amendment) Act, 2013.

### **Vision**

"To contribute to work force productivity, socio-economic development and social harmony through well rounded and industry relevant educational Programs with employment at the heart of academic offerings, technology at the heart of operations and academic mobility as the focus deploying inclusive, distributed and low cost delivery methodology."

### **Mission**

TLSU envisions striving towards socio-economic development through academic Programs, training, research and extension work. 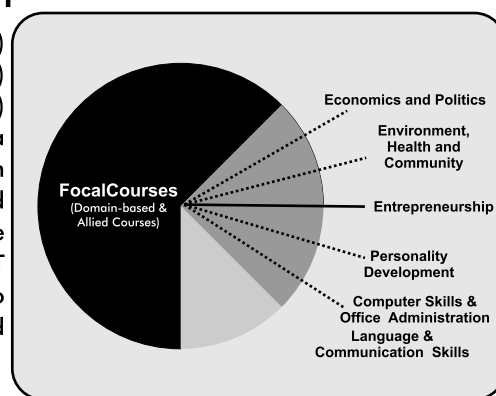
## 1.4 ACADEMIC PROGRAMS

TLSU degree programs provide you flexibility of study and modular curriculum. At present, the Undergraduate Programs carry two exit options- Two Year Associate Degree and Three Year Bachelor's Degree. Those students who wish to take a break from studies after successful completion of two years of the programme to take up a job, start own business, join family business or pursue any other interest shall be awarded an Associate Degree. In case, any issue arises from UGC for the offer of Associate Degree, alternatively Advanced Diploma will be awarded. Later, if a student decides to secure Degree qualification, student may contact the University for re-admission to the third year of the programme subject to prevalent curricular conditions and options.

In case a student chooses to complete three years of study continuously, he or she is eligible to acquire degree qualification on the fulfillment of stipulated requirements. Specific details on Associate Degree and Bachelor's Degree Programs are given in Sections 2 and Section 3.

## 1.5 COURSE CONTENT COMPOSITION WITH FOCUS ON EMPLOYABILITY

TLSU programs are designed keeping in view the need to inculcate-(i) Area competence (to shape its graduates as professionals) (ii) Employability skills (required for adjusting to the work place conditions) and (iii) Lifeskills (needed to transact activities in day-to-day life as a responsible citizen). The area competence is planned to be built through focal courses, which are a combination of domain based and allied courses. The employability skills and life skills are proposed to be inculcated through Focal Courses (Domain - based & Allied Courses) OJT generic courses and on-job- training (OJT) components. It is intended to allot significant time for on-job- training, which will have defined sequence of activities.



## 1.6 CREDIT SYSTEM

The University follows the ‘Credit System’ for all its Programs. The credit assignment is made depending on the hours of study and hands-on-work a student needs to do. The individual courses are assigned credit weightage.

## 1.7 PROGRAM DELIVERY

The methodology of instruction at TLSU will be different from that of many universities. TLSU believes in offering learner-oriented education. It signifies that you are an active participant in the teaching-learning process. As many of you could be from diverse age and occupational groups, a blended mode of instruction will be made available to facilitate admission and flexibility of study. The blended mode (also called hybrid mode) involves combined use of face-to-face teaching, web-mediated instruction, hands-on-work for practical experience and on- job - training for exposure to work place practices.

TLSU has made significant arrangements for making web-based learning a pleasant exercise. Industrial visits, seminars, conferences, and project work will add to job-oriented educational initiative. TLSU is creating an active base for industry-institution collaboration. The role of visiting faculty, mainly from the industries and industrial associations, will be a vital input in the instruction.

## 1.8 ASSESSMENT SYSTEM

The Assessment System at TLSU will have following three major components -

- Continuous Assessment - This may comprise of individual assignments, group assignments, surprise tests, quiz, practical assignments, project work, presentations, seminar etc.
- On - Job - Training (OJT) - This will be jointly supervised, assessed and graded by Faculty Supervisor of TLSU and Mentor of Industry / Corporate
- Mid-Term Examination-This comprises of course wise mid term written examination.
- End-Term Examination-This comprises of course wise semester - end written examination.

## ASSOCIATE & BACHELOR DEGREE PROGRAMS : APPLICATION DETAILS

### 2.1. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 2.1.1. The candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary Examination, 10+2 or its equivalent (HSC / Pre-University Course) are eligible for admission to the Associate Degree / Bachelor Degree Program.
- 2.1.2. The candidates who have passed the 10th Std + 2 Years of ITI Course are eligible for admission to the Associate Degree / Bachelor Degree Program.
- 2.1.3. The candidates who are expecting final year/semester results of their 10+2 or its equivalent course (HSC/Pre - University Course / 10 + 2 Years of ITI) are also eligible for admission.
- 2.1.4. The candidate must produce all the relevant documents in original at the time of admission.
- 2.1.5. The eligibility of candidates for different programs within the Departments at TLSU is as below -

**\*Note :** As per the Government Order No. M.S.B./1211/590/Ch Dated 02/06/2011, any candidate who has completed two or more years of GCVT / NCVT trade at ITI after 10th Std, are considered equivalent to 12th Std.

### 2.2. INSTRUCTIONS FOR DETERMINING ELIGIBILITY TO APPLY

- 2.2.1. Marks of the Higher Secondary Examination, 10+2 or its equivalent course (HSC / Pre-University Course / 10 + 2 Years of ITI) pursued by the candidate will be taken for determining his / her eligibility.
- 2.2.2. In case it is found that the information furnished by a candidate is incorrect or misleading or ineligibility being detected before or after the selection process / admission, his / her candidature will be cancelled without giving reasons thereof.

### 2.3. APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- 2.3.1. Obtaining and Submitting the Application Form :

Three options are available for obtaining the Application Form. The Prospectus (containing Application Form) can be obtained -

- In person; or
- Downloaded from TLSU website - [www.teamleaseuniversity.org](http://www.teamleaseuniversity.org); or
- Through post / courier.

The Application Fee is Rs. 100/- for (i) & (ii) and it is Rs. 150/- for (iii) above.

**Option I :** The Prospectus can be purchased directly from TLSU Campus on payment of Rs. 100/- (Rupees One Hundred Only) by cash. The duly filled Application Form can be submitted in person at TLSU Campus or sent through post/courier addressed to "Admissions Committee, Teamlease Skills University, Tarsali - Vadadala Road, Tarsali By-pass, Tarsali, Vadodara-390009, Gujarat".

**Option II :** The Prospectus can also be downloaded from TLSU website [www.teamleaseuniversity.org](http://www.teamleaseuniversity.org). The duly filled Application Form can be submitted in person at TLSU Campus alongwith Rs. 100/- (Rupees One Hundred Only) in cash. Alternatively the filled up Application Form can be sent to "Admissions Committee, Teamlease Skills University, Tarsali - Vadadala Road, Tarsali By-pass, Tarsali. Vadodara - 390009, Gujarat" through post/courier alongwith a demand draft (DD) for Rs. 100/- (Rupees One Hundred Only). The details of drawing the DD are given in section 2.3.2.

**Option III :** The candidates can request for the Prospectus by sending a letter containing full name and address and contact phone or mobile number of the candidate alongwith a DD for Rs. 150 /- (Rupees One Hundred Fifty Only) addressed to "Admissions Committee, Teamlease Skills University, Tarsali-Vadadala Road, Tarsali By-pass, Tarsali. Vadodara - 390009, Gujarat". The details of drawing the DD are given in section 2.3.2. Requests without a DD and / or without a proper address will not be accepted.

The duly filled Application Form can be submitted in person at TLSU Campus or sent through post/courier addressed to "Admissions Committee, Teamlease Skills University, Tarsali-Vadadala Road, Tarsali By-pass, Tarsali, Vadodara -390009, Gujarat".

Please note the Application Form fee paid by the candidate is not refundable under any circumstances.

### 2.3.2. Procedure for Drawing Demand Draft (DD) :

The DD can be drawn from any branch of State Bank of India / ICICI Bank / Axis Bank / HDFC Bank / Any Nationalized Bank in favour of "TeamLease Skills University", payable at Vadodara.

### 2.3.3. Last date for sending the filled-up Application Form : 10th July' 2015.

The decision of the Admission Committee of TLSU shall be final in relation to offer of admission based on the Applications received.

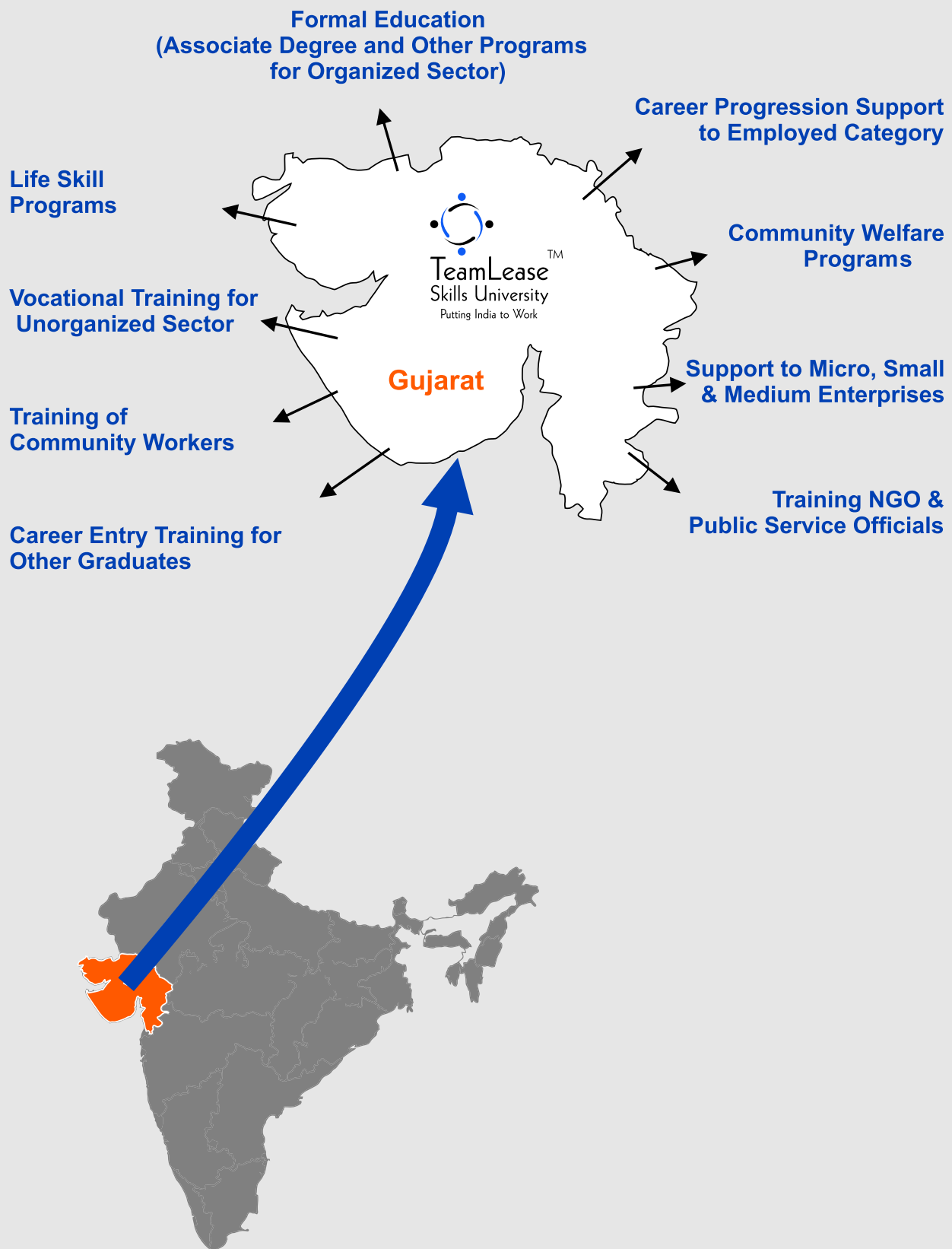

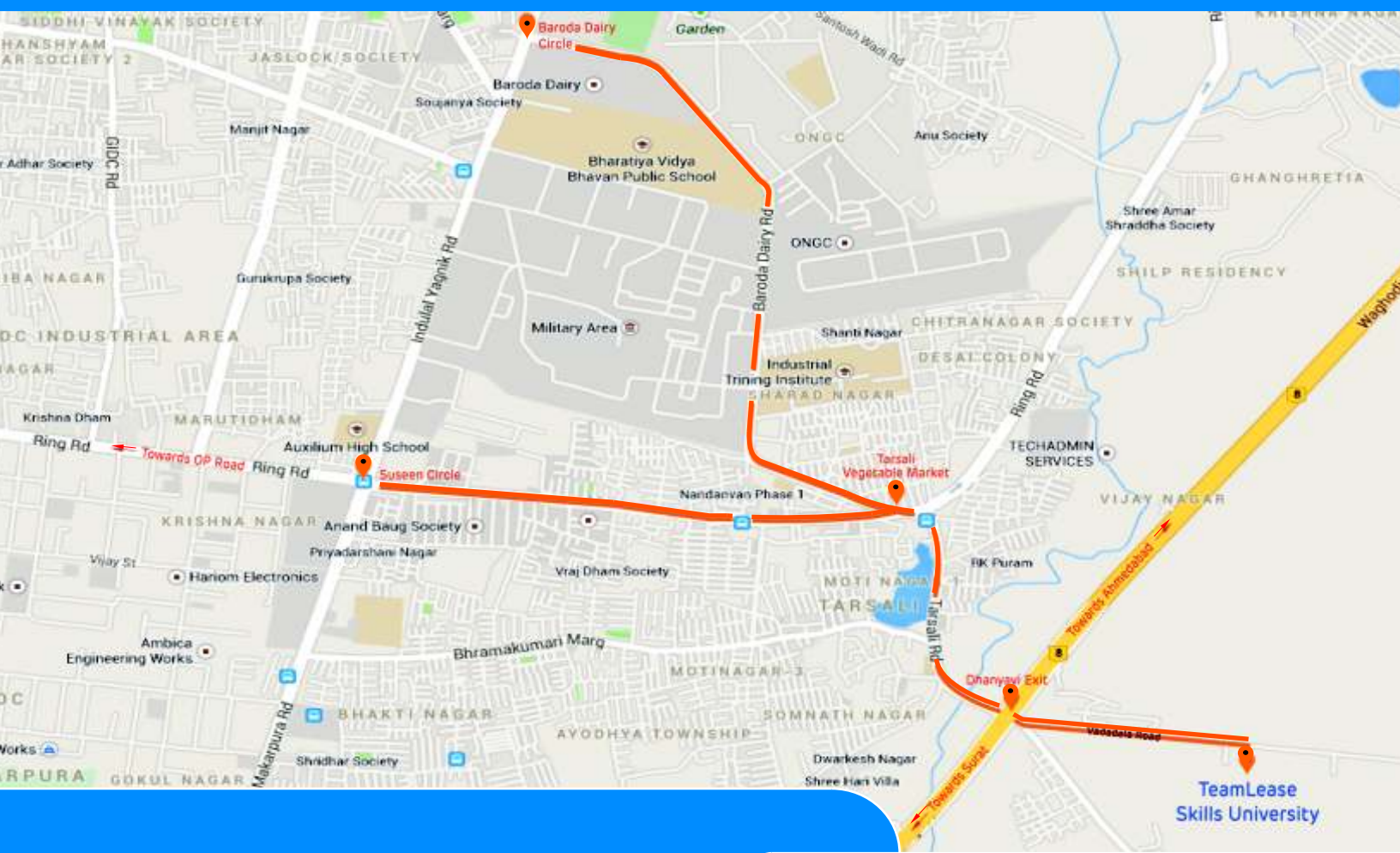
