The NETAP is India's largest and fastest growing degree linked apprenticeship program aligned to New Education Policy. In the year 2020-2021, NETAP engaged with 475 employers across sectors and geographies to execute apprenticeship. In the said year, NETAP added 10500 apprentices and ended the year with a total of 61500 apprentices. The two degree linked apprenticeship program under NETAP offered are BBA CRM and BSc in Mechatronics in FY 21. The program are offered through TLSU in the state of Gujarat (599 enrolments) and in the rest of the country through its partnership with Jain university (29776 enrolments). Apart from these, for the Short term Certificate Courses 15,796 students have been enrolled.</p>
